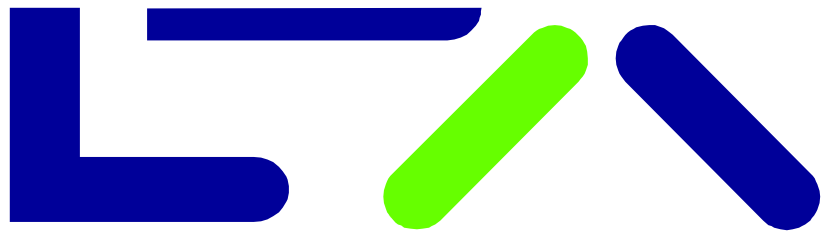

### Inditex: Extraordinary dividend

**Summary:**

The general meeting of the company Inditex decided to pay a final dividend of EUR 0.242 per share, of which EUR 0.10 is an extraordinary dividend.

The extraordinary dividend will result in an adjustment of the Eurex option (IXD), the Eurex Single Stock Futures contracts (IXDK, IXDL, IXDQ) and the Eurex Single Stock Dividend Futures contracts (I3XD, I4XD, I5XD) on shares of Inditex.

Ex date will be **3 November 2014**.

This circular contains a description of the adjustment procedure.

The ISIN of the Inditex share (ES0148396007) will remain unchanged

**Procedure:****Determination of adjustment factor (R-factor)**

The closing auction price of the Inditex share at Bolsa de Madrid on the last cum trading day will be the basis for the adjustment. First, this price will be reduced by the regular dividend (EUR 0.142). The price resulting from this is used for determination of the adjustment factor (R-factor):

S1	Closing auction price of the Inditex share
S2	S1 minus regular dividend EUR 0.142
S3	S2 minus extraordinary dividend EUR 0.10
R-factor	$S3 / S2$

**Options****1. Adjustment of strike prices and contract sizes**

All existing strike prices will be multiplied by the R-factor.

The contract size will be divided by the R-factor.

The version number of the existing series will be increased by 1.

Adjusted strike prices and contract sizes will be published via the **Market Supervision Messages** window immediately after close of trading on the last cum trading day.

New series with standard contract size 100 and version number 0 will be introduced effective the ex-date.

All existing orders and quotes will be deleted after close of trading on the last cum trading day.

The adjustment also refers to existing positions in OTC Flexible Options.

## 2. Exercises

Generally, upon exercise of an adjusted series, cash payment will be made for the fractional part of the new contract size.

For adjusted series as of version 2, deviations in the delivery process might occur. In report RPTTA111 (All Active/Inactive Series), those parts of the contract size are displayed for which cash settlement takes place upon exercise of an adjusted series.

## Futures

### 1. Adjustment of contract size and variation margin

The adjustment will be made with the same factor as for the options.

To adjust the calculation of the variation margin of the following exchange trading day, settlement prices of the last cum trading day will be multiplied by the R-factor.

The new contract size will be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Contract size new} = \text{contract size old} / \text{R-factor}$$

All outstanding orders and quotes will be deleted after close of trading on the last cum trading day.

The adjustment also refers to existing positions in OTC Flexible Futures.

### 2. Introduction of new contracts

New Eurex Single Stock Futures contracts will be introduced on Inditex shares with standard contract size 100 and product codes IXDM and IXDR. Furthermore, a new Eurex Single Stock Dividend Futures contract will be introduced on Inditex shares with standard contract size 1000 and product code I5XD.

The exact introduction date will be published in a separate Eurex circular.

As soon as the new contracts are available for trading and there are no more contract months with open interest in the original contracts on Inditex shares (IXDK, IXDL, IXDQ, I3XD, I4XD, I5XD), trading in these contracts will be put on "HALT" and finally discontinued.

Furthermore, no new contract months will be introduced in the original contracts (IXDK, IXDL, IXDQ, I3XD, I4XD, I5XD). Existing contract months without open interest will be suspended from trading.

**If there is no open interest on the last cum trading day after close of trading in one of the original contracts on Inditex shares (IXDK, IXDL, IXDQ, I3XD, I4XD, I5XD), no adjustment will be made for this contract and no new contract will be introduced.**

23 October 2014
