In order to ease the certificate creation process and further improve the safety of the systems, Eurex Clearing revised the related processes. From **16 April 2015** onwards, Member certificates will be signed by Deutsche Börse AG as certificate authority (CA).

Upon request, Members are provided with a new certificate issued on Member level that can be used for all users of the Clearing GUIs mentioned below. Members using one of these GUIs are no longer required to create and sign their own certificates. Upload of the self-signed certificates into the Member Section on the Eurex Clearing website [www.eurexclearing.com](http://www.eurexclearing.com) is no longer available from 16 April 2015 onwards.

Members using one of these GUIs are no longer required to create and sign their own certificates. Upload of the self-signed certificates into Member Section on the Eurex Clearing website [www.eurexclearing.com](http://www.eurexclearing.com) is no longer available from 16 April 2015 onwards.

The following GUI applications are in scope of the revised certificate process:

- C7 Derivatives Clearing GUI
- EurexOTC Clear GUI
- EurexOTC Clear Margin Calculator GUI
- Securities Clearing GUI

Certificates which are already available in the Member Section can still be used to access the Clearing GUIs, however Eurex Clearing recommends requesting the creation of a new certificate and deletion of the account with the self-signed certificate from the Member Section.

The following two options are available for obtaining a signed certificate:

- **(A)** Eurex Clearing generates an encrypted certificate including all required details on behalf of the Member. Members can download a ready-to-use certificate from the Member Section and install the certificate into the internet browser using a PIN which is transferred separately via e-mail to ensure confidentiality.
- **(B)** Members can generate a private key to create a certificate signing request (CSR) and request Eurex Clearing to sign the CSR.

**Option (A)** requires the following steps on the Member's side:

1. Submit filled-out certificate request form via e-mail to [ClearingCertificates@eurexclearing.com](mailto:ClearingCertificates@eurexclearing.com).
2. The Member will receive an e-mail notification informing the Member that the certificate is available for download. This message includes the PIN which is required for installation of the certificate into the internet browser.
3. The certificate is available for download in the Member Section of the Eurex Clearing website [www.eurexclearing.com](http://www.eurexclearing.com) under the following path:  
**Member Section > Technical Connection >  
Requests & Configuration > Current Configuration**
4. Install the certificate into the internet browser.

**Option (B)** requires the following steps on the Member's side:

1. Generation of a CSR. Refer to the "Clearing GUIs – Access Guide" available on the website of Eurex Clearing for further instructions (see download path below).
2. Submit filled-out certificate request form via e-mail to [ClearingCertificates@eurexclearing.com](mailto:ClearingCertificates@eurexclearing.com) including the CSR as attachment with the file name: <businesspartnerID>\_<memberID>\_CSR.csr.
3. The Member will receive an e-mail notification informing the Member that the certificate is available for download.

4. The certificate is available for download in the Member Section of the Eurex Clearing website under the path:

**Member Section > Technical Connection > Requests & Configuration > Current Configuration**

5. Merge the signed certificate with the private key stored on Member's device.
6. Install the certificate into the internet browser.
