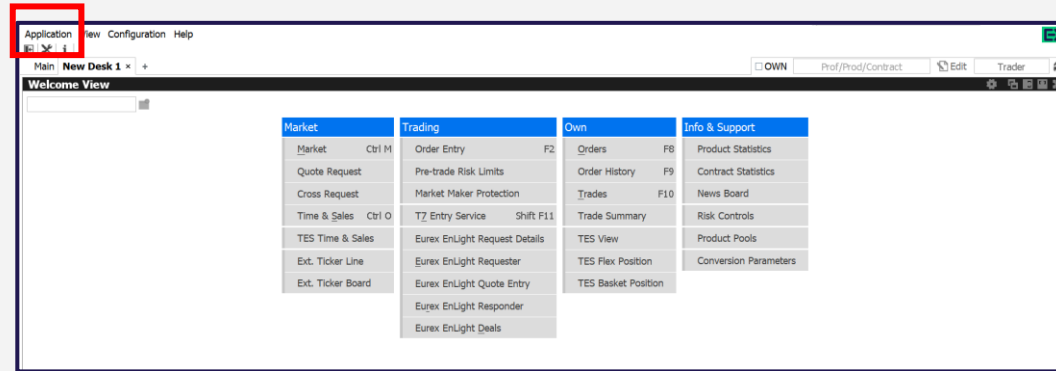

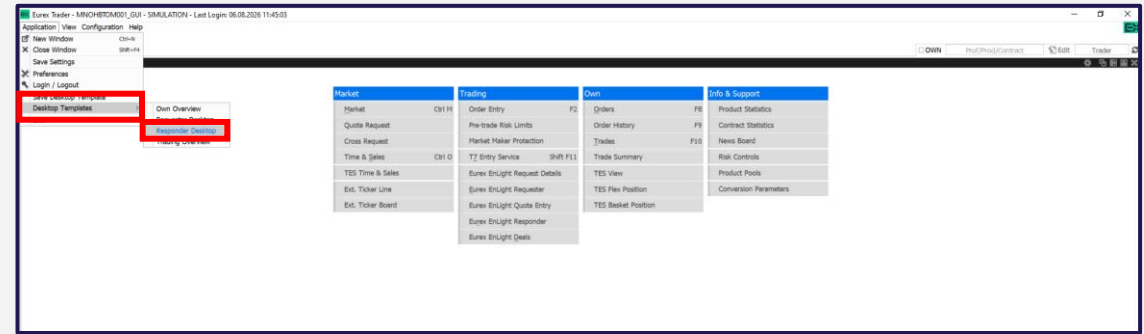
1 Responder Quick Start Guide Firm Workflow

How to Set-up the Responder Desktop Template

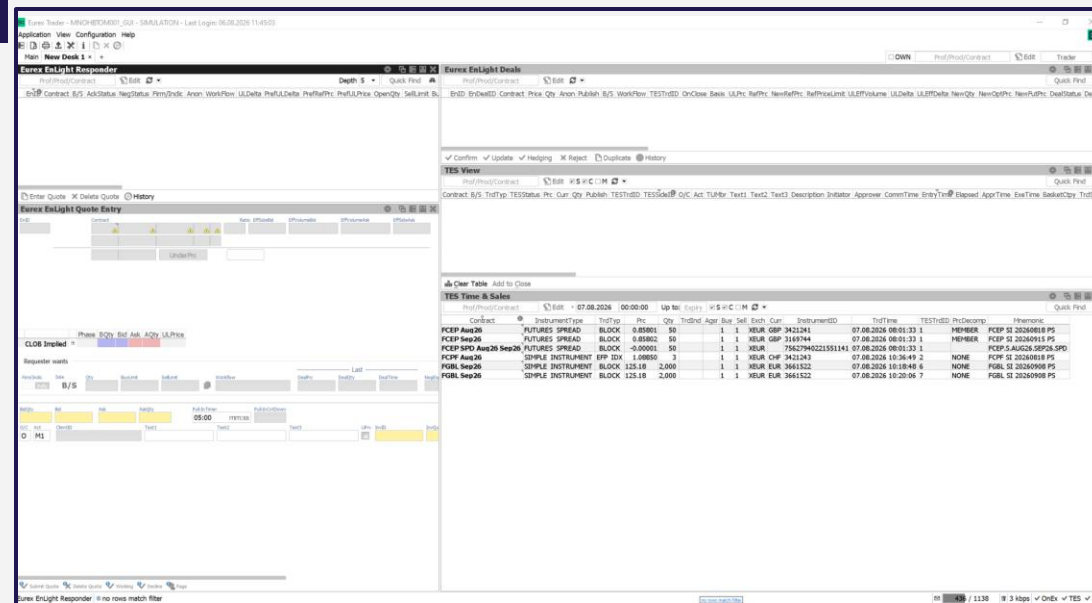
Step 1 Click on “Application” on the top left over the Welcome View



Step 2 Click on “Desktop Templates” and then on “Responder Desktop”

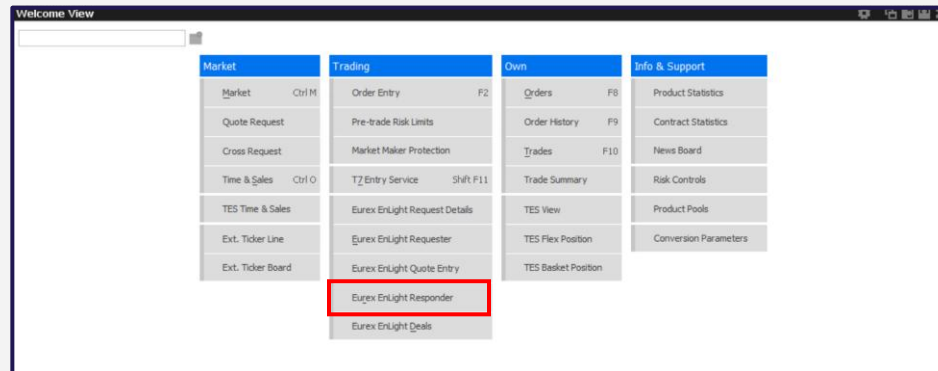


On the Responder Desktop, you will find the following windows required to complete the process.

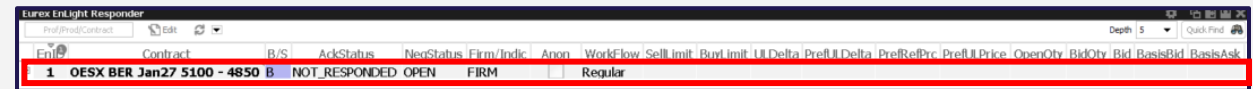
- Eurex EnLight Responder window

RFQ Response Process

Step 1 Select “Eurex EnLight Responder” on T7 User Interface.



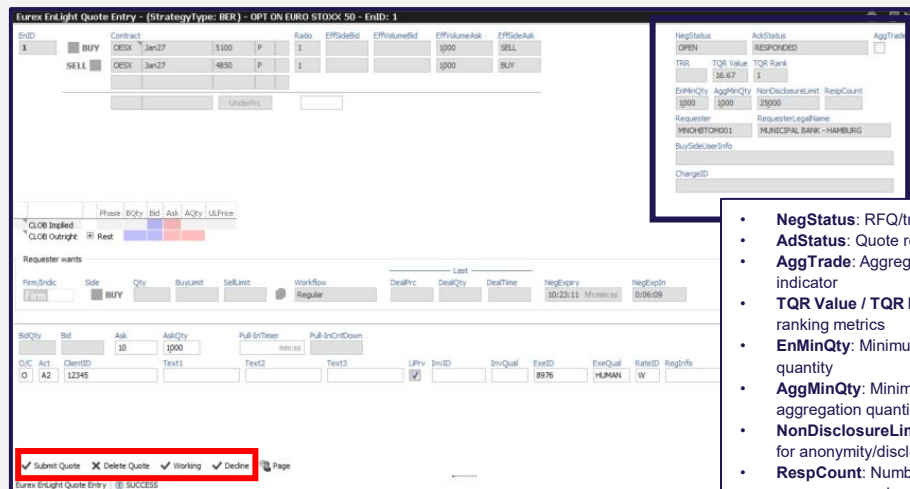
Step 2 A list of open RFQs sent to you will appear on the Responder blotter. Incoming RFQs are briefly highlighted in yellow and trigger both a sound alert and a pop-up notification. Double click on the desired RFQ.



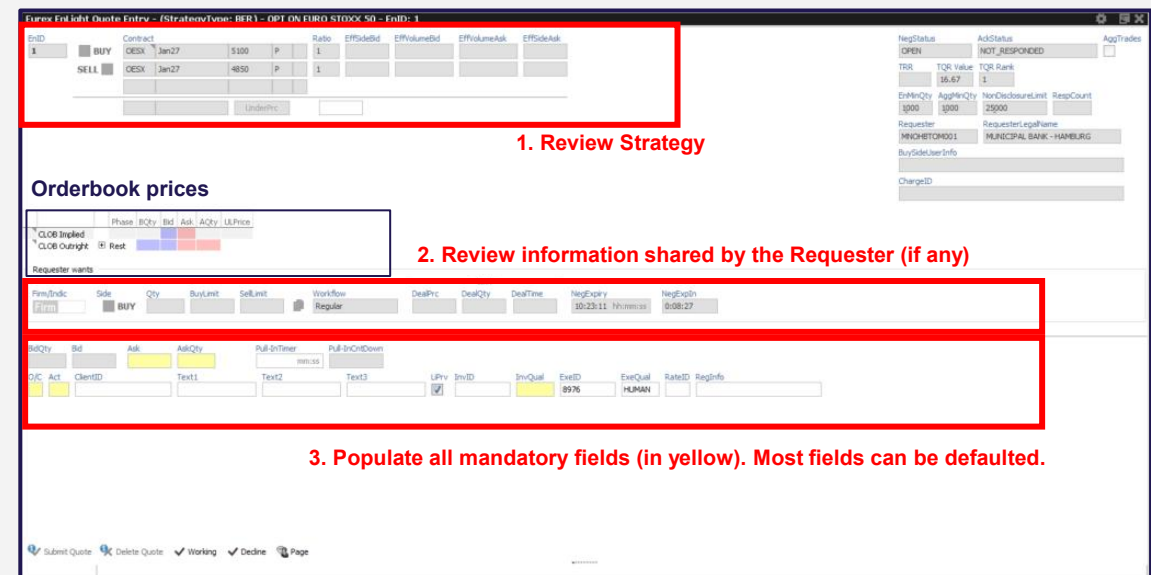
Step 3 Review RFQ and respond with a quote.

You can utilize a copy icon to quickly populate your quote fields with information disseminated by the requester. Some fields can be populated with default values set in the window properties menu (settings icon). By right-clicking and using the arrow keys, you can select options from the dropdown menu or adjust values. Please refer to page 8 of this document for further details.

Step 4a Click “Submit Quote”, “Delete Quote”, “Working” (pricing up quote), or “Decline” to submit a response.



- **NegStatus:** RFQ/trade status
- **AdStatus:** Quote response status
- **AggTrade:** Aggregated trade indicator
- **TQR Value / TQR Rank:** RFQ ranking metrics
- **EnMinQty:** Minimum eligible quantity
- **AggMinQty:** Minimum aggregation quantity
- **NonDisclosureLimit:** Threshold for anonymity/disclosure
- **RespCount:** Number of responses received
- **BuySideUserInfo:** Additional buy-side client information
- **ChargeID:** Internal reference ID

Working

- “Working” = Pricing in Progress
- After you have selected “Working” you are still able to perform any action. *i.e. submit a quote, delete a quote, decline responding.*

Decline

The requester is informed that you have declined to quote for the RFQ. You are no longer able to respond.

When the quote is submitted and the transaction is confirmed it is reflected in both the Eurex EnLight Deals and TES View windows (refer to next page).

Sub-Tick Quote Submission

If you quote on a quantity that is at least twice the MBTS then you will be able to quote in sub-ticks. There will be no differences in the workflow but once the deal is final two deals will be created by EnLight that produce the synthetic sub-tick value quoted and subsequently agreed.

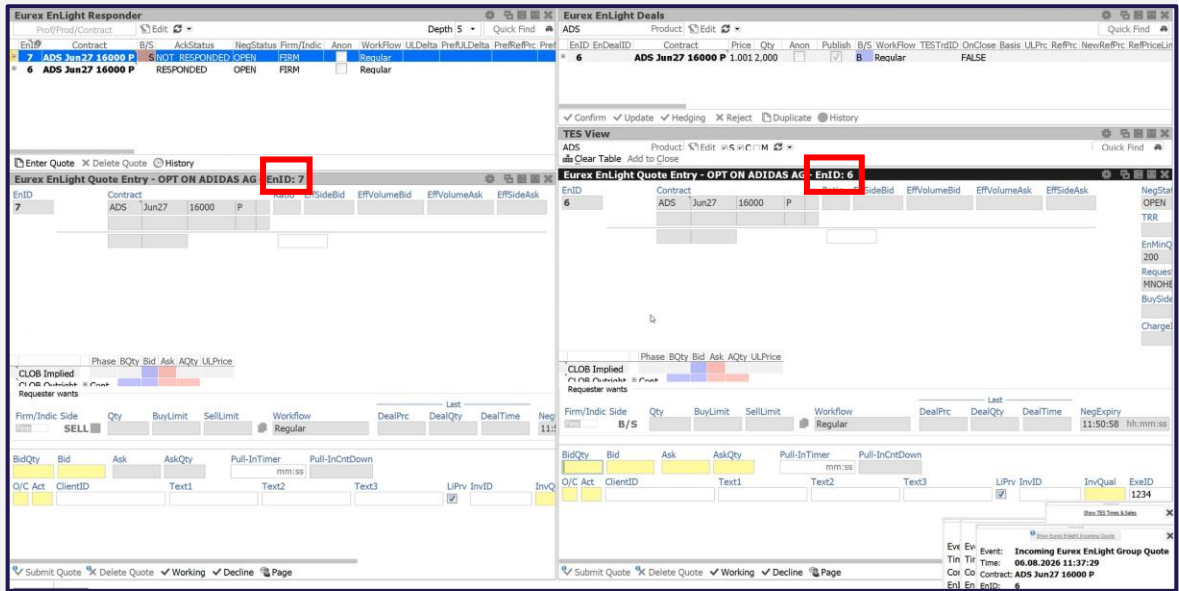

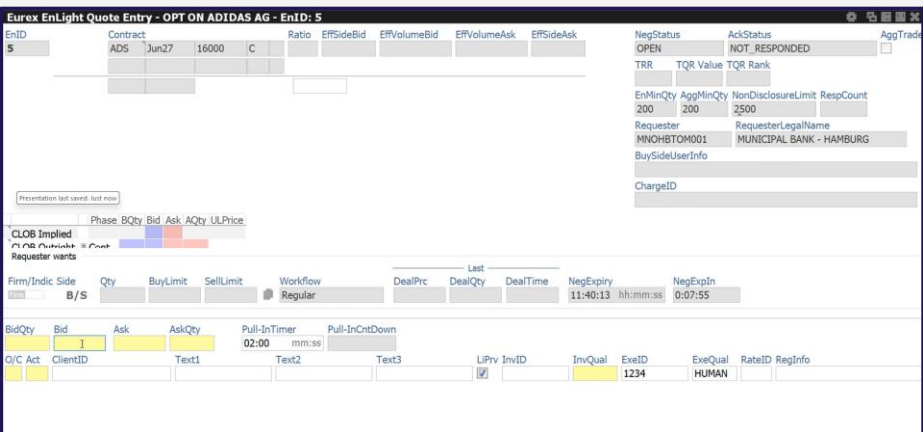
Additional Information

Multiple Quote Windows



When multiple Quote Windows are open, each window is assigned a unique EnID. The EnID is displayed in the Quote Window header. This identifier helps users distinguish between different quote sessions and avoid working in the wrong window.

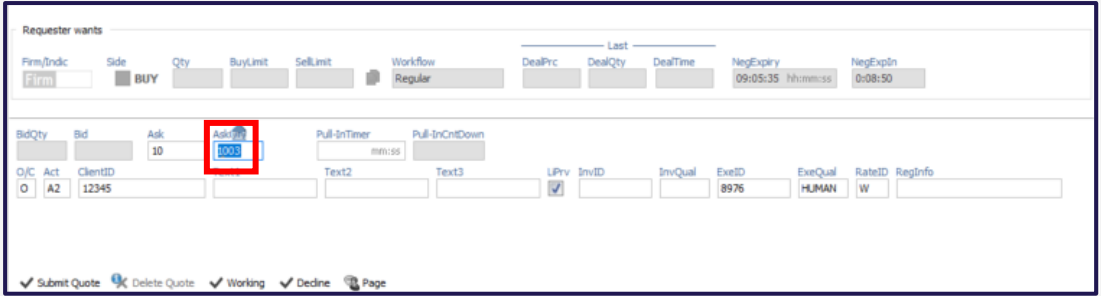
Pull-In Timer



Pull-In Timer can be configured by the user and indicates the remaining lifetime of an active quote. Once the timer reaches zero, the quote is automatically pulled unless it has been updated or acted upon beforehand. The timer helps users track quote validity and manage active quoting sessions efficiently.

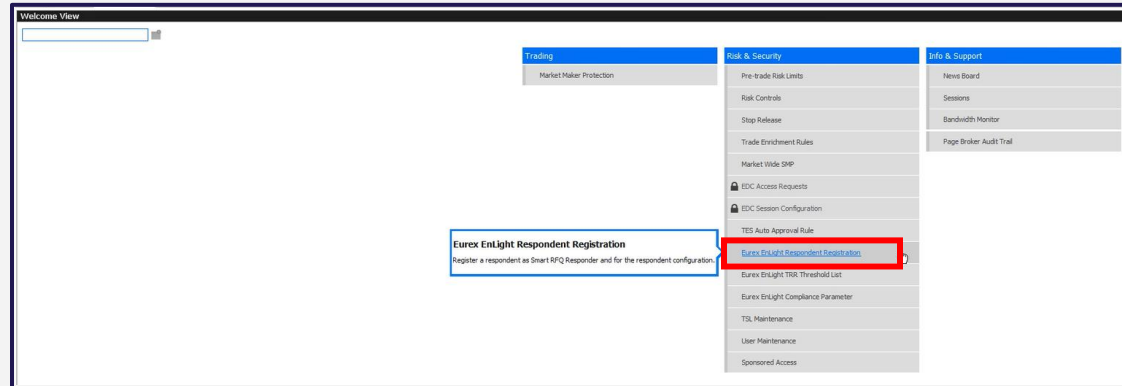
Value & Price Adjustment

Adjust values and prices by navigating up and down using either the mouse or arrow keys and modifying values or fields as needed. It is possible to click 'Working' whilst already working a quote. This will pull the current quote and notify the Requester to standby for a re-priced quote.

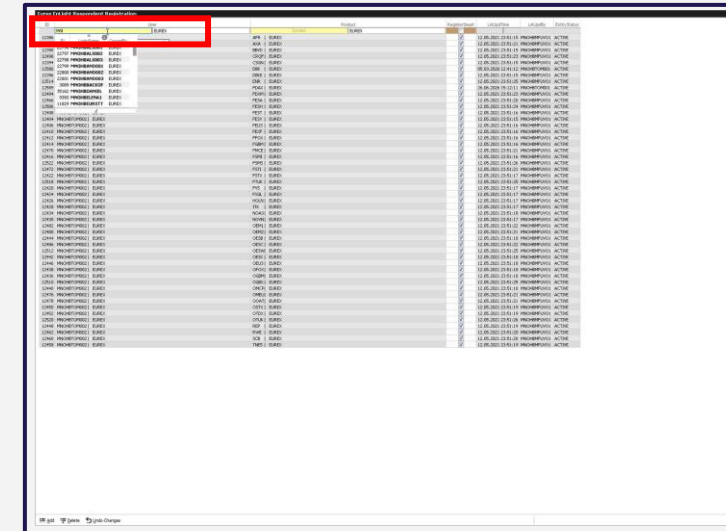


Responder Registration via T7 Admin Gui

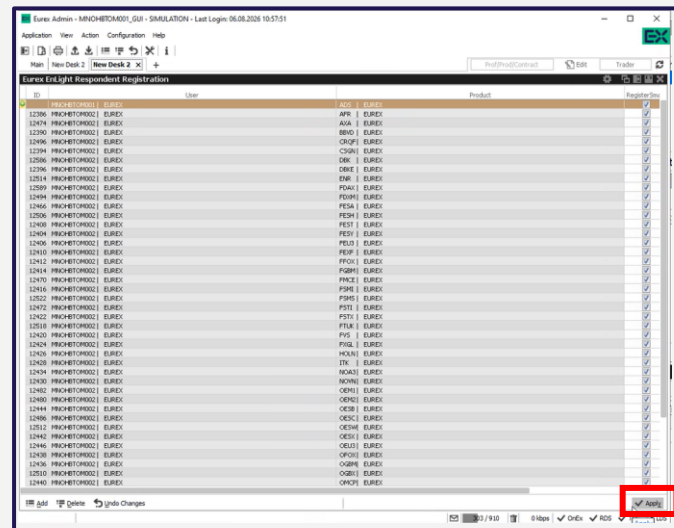
Step 1 Welcome View: Click on “Eurex EnLight Responder Registration”



Step 2 Search for and select the responder to be added to the Responder List



Step 3 Tick the registration checkbox for the selected responder and click Apply to save the changes.



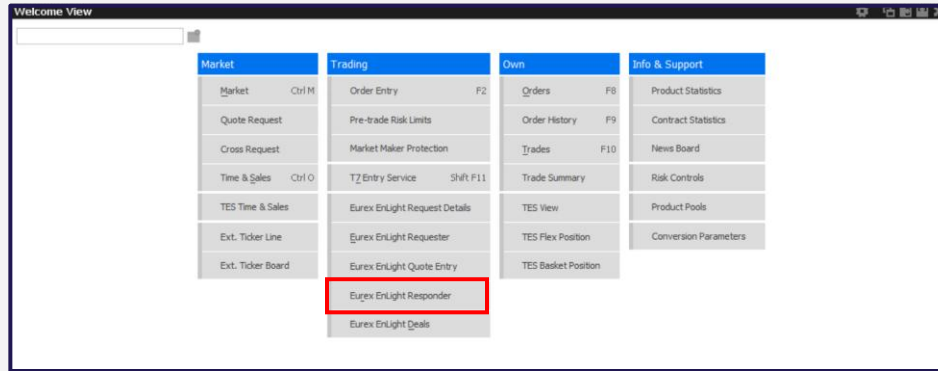
Alternative Registration Method

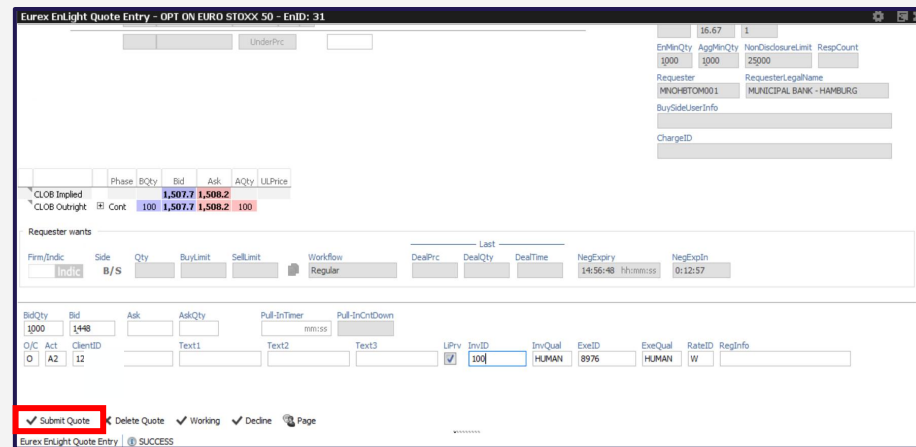
